NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS Rules Applying to Dog Shows Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. For complete detail of the rule change see <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf>.

NOTE: When a dog is entered in more than one class, the highest price class is considered the first entry. **'Puppy'** classes stop at 9-12 MOS. Sweepstakes entry must also be entered in a Regular Class.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES RULES

The Sweepstakes is open to all Pekingese over 6 months of age and under 18 months of age who **ALSO ARE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS**. Champions of Record are not eligible. Entry is to be made at the same time and on the same form as entries for the regular classes. ***"Sweepstakes" and class should be stated in the space provided for Additional Classes.***

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

- Sweepstakes, Puppy, 6 Months of Age and Under 9 Months
- Sweepstakes, Puppy, 9 Months of age and Under 12 Months
- Sweepstakes, Junior, 12 Months of Age and Under 18 Months

Sweepstakes will be judged prior to regular classes and Sweepstakes entry fee is \$17.00 per entry added to the regular class fee. Thirty-five (35%) percent of the Sweepstakes entry fees will be retained by the Club. The balance of the entry fees in that class will be divided among the winners of each class as follows:

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of the entry without the Agreement and Rules from the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Errors on Entry Blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Show-giving Club, Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs, or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children under the control of parents or guardians.

A recording fee of 50 cents and an event fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club, Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fee is collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2)

All dogs must be held on leash except when in the exercise area or crated.C.

The participating Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.

Transfer of Entry to Best of Breed Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.
